★ Navigate VA Aid & Attendance Benefits

The VA Aid and Attendance benefit provides tax-free monthly income to Wartime Veterans, living Spouses and Surviving Spouses that reduces out-of-pocket costs and allows for additional care.

Eligibility is determined by wartime service, status and need for care.

Wartime Service

At least 90 days active service,
with at least one (1) day during
recognized wartime periods

Any discharge other than
dishonorable

Eligible Wartime Periods

World War II

December 7, 1941 - December 31, 1946

Korean Conflict

June 27, 1950-January 21, 1955

Vietnam War Era*

February 28, 1961 - May 7, 1975

**Inside the Republic of Vietnam*

August 5, 1964 - May 7, 1975

**Outside the Republic of Vietnam*
